The CODE project believes that access to financial services is not just a necessity, it is a right.

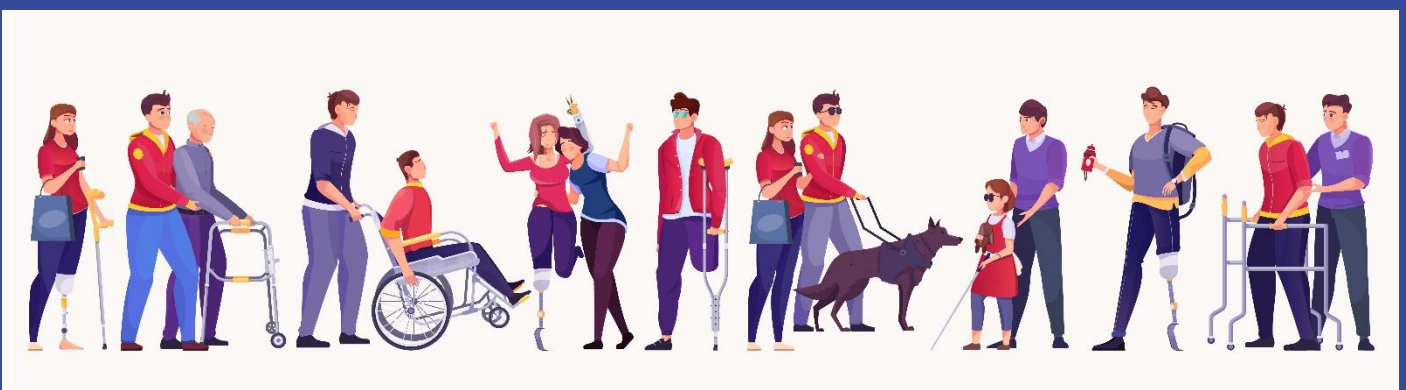
